**2. Declarations of Interest**

**3. AVDC Draft Technical reports to inform the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan (VALP) Issues and Options consultant.**

Councillors formulated a response to the Issues and Options paper (dated October 2015); the latest consultation paper for the Vale of Aylesbury Local Plan. This consultation document sets out background studies and broad options for growth in the District. Councillors recommendations were:

- The Plan should adequately provide for low-cost housing and the needs of the elderly.
- Housing allocations should reflect the specific characteristics of each settlement and not be based on a standard formula.
- The main growth should be borne by the larger settlements with the possible scope for a new settlement later in the Plan period.
- Housing allocations for the smaller villages such as Cuddington should be tailored to the needs of the community and the capacity to accommodate change.
- The Areas of Attractive Landscape designation that covers the village and its setting should be retained.

**ACTION: KT to submit online response by 4<sup>th</sup> December 2015.** The next stage of the process will be the publication of a draft Plan in Spring 2016. The VALP will be adopted by Summer 2017.
